Protect your treasures

Ensure that your home is protected with some useful tips from the National Trust's insurance partner RSA.

- Make sure you mark your property with an engraving tool or invisible ultra violet pen.
- Install a burglar alarm and fit the box in a prominent position.
- Always set the alarm before leaving the house.
- Always remove keys from inside doors and windows, especially if the lock can be reached through the letterbox.
- Always keep your car and house keys hidden from plain sight when they're in the house too.
- All your external doors should ideally have 3 locking points. Mortice locks are a useful deterrent to would-be burglars.
- Gravel is a cheap security measure for paths and driveways. The crunching noise makes it very difficult for thieves to sneak quietly around outside your house.

By using just some of these security tips you could help reduce your home insurance premium.
